OBJECTIVES OF THE PROGRAMME :

The main aims of the Pandemic and Epidemic Diseases (PED) department are: 1) to make available to others expert knowledge and guidance based on scientific evidence and public health experience relating to the prevention and control of epidemic and pandemic infectious diseases and related risks such as antimicrobial resistance; 2) to develop, implement, facilitate or coordinate the mechanisms, activities, public health research and initiatives needed by countries and the international community to prevent, detect, assess, notify and respond to acute and longer term public health risks related to pandemic and epidemic diseases; 3) to strengthen, support and promote important measures such as research, vaccination, treatment and infection control that are critical for mitigating the impact of infectious diseases; and 4) to provide programmatic support during outbreaks and other urgent health security events. The department covers influenza and other respiratory diseases, cholera, hepatitis, meningitis, yellow fever, and numerous other dangerous pathogens as well as the management of specific related systems, networks and groups. This list may change over time.

Description of duties:

1. Manage project work plan development.
2. Provide technical guidance and establish a process for the development of coordinated WHO work plans and budgets for the Antimicrobial Drug Resistance (AMR).
3. Develop strategies, streamlined procedures and formats to ensure effective use of funds, timely reporting and monitoring of implementation.
4. Manage project implementation, monitoring and reporting.
5. Provide technical and logistical support for planning, communicating, convening and documenting technical and strategic consultations with stakeholders to promote intersectoral engagement and partnering for the development of a global action plan to tackle AMR.
6. Ensure the development and timely submission of technical and financial reports to advisory groups, donors and governing bodies.
